
WIDE RAINBOW LESSONS: Artist Carrie Mae Weems

ARTIST INTRO:

Carrie Mae Weems (b. 1953) is considered one of the most influential contemporary American artists of our time. Weems is best known for her photography that explores race, identity, class, political systems, and family dynamics. For over thirty years her photographs, films, and videos center on issues facing African Americans. She is a MacArthur Genius, has received numerous awards, recognitions, and her work is exhibited and housed in major museum collections worldwide. During the pandemic she started an awareness campaign and nationwide public artwork known as "RESIST COVID / TAKE 6".
